

Ms. Vancavage's CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR SYSTEM

Below is the behavior hierarchy that I use in my classroom. Each student begins every day at the top - SUPER STAR. Throughout the day, if necessary, students can be asked to move their name down the "ladder" to warning, timeout, etc. They move their name if they are not following the classroom rules, having to be spoken to more than 3 times to follow directions, not doing their work, etc.

However, students are allowed to move their name back up the "ladder" when they get back on target; finish their work, listening & following directions, helping other students, etc. As always there is room for improvement.

This is then marked on their behavior sheet that goes home every night to be signed so you can see how your child's day was at school.

If you have any questions or concerns about the behavior systems/strategies or incentive programs that I use in my classroom please let me know.

As you read through all the documents that I have given you and discussed there are many supports in the classroom for my students - however, if you feel as though a specific behavior chart is necessary, in addition to what is in place in our classroom, we can work together to create one for your child's needs.
