We will begin our programs next week as we rotate each homeroom through the three subject areas.

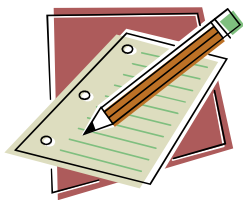
- Each classroom will be engaged in a variety of getting-to-know-you activities during the first week.
