- Dewey Decimal number

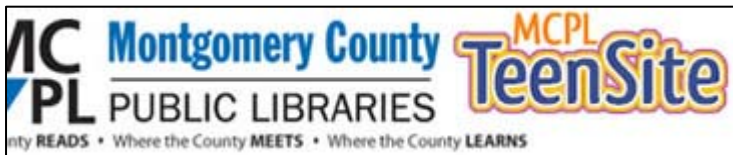
