
OFF LIMITS for students during STEP:

- **E-hallway—all three levels unless with a teacher**
- **T-hallway — closed for congregation**
- **All stairwells, landings, steps, etc. (No sitting or loitering)**
- **Locker room hallway—unless accompanied by a teacher or coach**
- **All bathrooms are locked except those at the major intersections on all three floors**
- **Outdoors— Students are allowed only in the areas between the basketball court and the back of the cafeteria (all other areas are off limits)**
- **Parking lots**
- **Outside and inside front of the main entrance**

More TIPS to maximize success in STEP...

- **Participate in at least one extracurricular activity, club, or sport. Address bathroom needs during this time**
- **Throw away all garbage in trash cans**
- **Do not hang in stairways or bathrooms**
- **Carry your Student ID at all times**
- **Do not go to the parking lot or leave school grounds**

STEP is an opportunity for all students to enhance their academic experience at the Mill.

- **The first 25 minutes of STEP has been designated as Extended Learning Time (ELT)**
- **Students are REQUIRED to attend ELT when assigned by a staff member**
- **Staff may assign students detention during STEP (maximum time of 25 minutes)**

Regular school lunch will be available in the cafeteria. A-la-carte lunches will be available at the satellite concession stand in the auditorium lobby. Refreshments and snacks will be sold at the school store across from the cafeteria and at the concession stand in the gymnasium lobby.

If you get free or reduced meals, you must get your lunch in the *hot line* of the cafeteria. Please have your Student ID ready to make the transaction.

- **Students who put money in their account should also have their Student IDs to make transactions**
- **Remember your access code and do not share it with other students**

Recommendation:

Bring a bag lunch to maximize your time during STEP.



Electronic Devices

Cell phones may not be on or visible during the hours of 7:20 am-2:10 pm.

- **Make up assignments and tests**

- **Socialize and build relationships with peers and adults**
- **Access counseling services**
- **Serve detentions**
