**Secretary's Report:** The minutes from our March 3, 2009, meeting was presented by Karen Kerr. Anne Alban made a motion for approval, Kathy Smyrk seconded and approval was unanimous.

**Treasurer's Report:** Jim was not present, but planned to email the budget. Expenditures were the mulch sale.

### **Old Business:**

**ECA Requests** – Winn inquired about the ECA payments.

**Nominating Committee** – Elections will be performed at the May meeting. Kathy Smyrk and Dan Ratliff will provide the nominee slate for distribution.

**Defending the Caveman** – Online sales continue to be progressing at a slow pace. Anne Alban will explore the option of FREE radio station ads. Second payment of 3K needs to be sent to Theatre Mogul with a balance of 5K on the night of April 24<sup>th</sup>.

### **New Business:**

**AAU Basketball** – nothing new to report.

**Graduation Costs** – Anne stated Boosters are not being asked to fund staff buses for graduation. School busses will be used to transport all staff to constitution hall.

**Golf Tournament** – Larry Yates provided details regarding plans to sponsor a golf tournament (on a Monday) in the fall of 2009 at the Montgomery Village Golf Course. Cost would be approximately \$100 per person, (this would include green fees, cart, lunch and goodie bag) with capacity of 100+ golfers. Hole sponsors would be set at \$250 per hole (including longest drive and closest to the pin). Mulligan sales at \$5 and raffle tickets at two for \$5 or five for \$10. The final date has been set for Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>.

**Marquee Plan** – Discussion was held whether we continue to raise funds for electronic marquee as a long term fundraiser when there are many other expenses relating to the condition of our stadium field to reduce the possibility of further injuries to our students and allow field hockey the choice of playing in the stadium.

**Scholarships** – There is 3K in scholarship money to be awarded. Karen will send Ed Ross the senior membership list and decisions will be made based on GPA, participation and academics.
