

Bibliographic Citation Worksheet Online Subscription Database

As you identify sources and gather information from them, **also collect the important facts that describe that source for your Works Cited page or bibliography**. An online subscription database citation has two parts. Part 1 describes the original source, which is usually a print or an electronic resource (i.e. CD-Rom). Part 2 describes the subscription database used to retrieve the information electronically.
