Tricia Skelly called meeting to order at 7:31 p.m.

- I. Introductions included:
 - Kevin Maxwell
 - Sue Amos, and
 - Booster Club President, Tricia Skelly
- II. Minutes for previous meeting were approved as written.
- III. Treasurer's Report: Arlene Fornace
 - About \$13,900 in account
 - We owe approximately \$1,000 to Photography Club; final amount not yet determined
- IV. Commissioner Report: Adeen Postar
 - Football, cheerleading, Boys and Girls Varsity and JV Field Hockey, Soccer and Cross-Country are covered
 - Student passes may no longer be sold by the Booster Club but will be sold by the Athletic Department
- V. Concession Update: Jane Slacter
 - Looking for captains to open concession stand and oversee the activities that evening
 - At end of year, Booster Club gets half of that income and teams get an amount per event (tallied up over course of year)
- VI. Membership: Mary Ruttkay
 - \$5,060 in membership fees to date (attachment)
 - 24 Hall of Famers \$2,400
 - 103 people signed up
- VII. Athletic Director's Report: Sue Amos
 - Had to purchase additional uniforms for many athletes, including football
 - Will give update on budget at next meeting
 - Paying for 3 buses/per game for Varsity football, 2 buses for JV football
 - \$16,000-\$20,000 for transportation
 - We must charge for all stadium games; right now choosing not to charge for volleyball
 - Admission fees are \$5 for adults, \$3 for students, \$1 per child
 - Students need picture ID (can be old ones) or will be charged \$5.00
 - Sale of cards for season:
 - \$30 adults, \$18 students: all income is used for athletics

- Cards will be sold three times per year
- VIII. Principal's Report: Kevin Maxwell
- Gym floor was redone this summer and fixed the lights
 - Weight Room is installed and in operation and new sign
 - Safety certification is required for use of the Weight Room. A sign-in sheet to enter.
 - All of the machines and weights were donated by the Booster Club
 - Opened school with all rooms but one dark room and one art room operational
 - Cannot use auditorium until additional lights are installed
 - Kitchen/cafeteria on schedule for a possible October 31 opening (the schedule calls for December opening)
 - Gym and auditorium renovation may be moved earlier from 2007 to 2004/2005
 - "It's Academic" is taping this Saturday
- IX. 10K Race Report: Tricia Skelly
- Need a new race director
 - May 18, 2003 – Save the Date for the Race!
 - We have people for many of the jobs already
 - Received compliments from Road Runner's Club and others as to how well the run was operated
 - Push to get the high school students to participate and volunteer
