- I. Athletic Director's Report: Sue Amos
 - a. Sue asked for funding for large wall mats at either end of the gym that will be placed against the walls behind the baskets. The cost is \$2,335.60.
Approved.
 - b. Sue also discussed the loss of revenues because we did not have the Homecoming game. We may get some reimbursement from the State.
 - c. Fall passes will be good for about 10 games the next season to make up for missing games.
 - d. There will a meeting for the parents of winter athletes on Tuesday, November 26. The principal purpose is to meet the coaches and to understand the ground rules as far as missing classes, etc.
