Minutes for the March 10, 2004 meeting were approved as written.

Since the last meeting a vote was conducted by email concerning a funding request of \$500 by Mr. Bartman for the Art Department/Art Club. The funding was approved.

REPORTS:

Administration: Carol Goddard

- The rededication of the school last Saturday went well.
- The administration is in the middle of staffing projections. Population projections give us an allocation for 5.4 more teachers.
- The middle school and high school teachers job fair will be held May 3-6. On May 3 it will take place at WJ from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM. The county does not provide food, so this is an opportunity to make money. Approximately 10 high schools and their middle schools are involved. Ideas on what to serve were discussed. Carol will email the schools to let them know that a light meal will be available for a reasonable price.

Athletics: Sue Amos

- Playoff games will be starting by the second week in May. As of now, all teams have a chance to be in the playoffs.
- Next week we should have the windscreens for the tennis court.
- Concern was expressed about the look of the back of the school, since so many teams are using our fields. BCC baseball put in sod, which requires watering.

Treasurer: Arlene Fornace

- The current balance is \$21,496 with a large deposit pending.

Concessions: Jane Slacter

- All games are currently covered for concessions. The football team worked at the Woodward Relays.
- We are not able to make ice in the school. First aid kits now have cold packs.
- The Booster Club is always looking for commissioners.
- Since it continues to be difficult to get the clubs to sign up to work the concession stand, the suggestion was made that they be required to sign up at the beginning-of-year meeting. If they don't sign up, they will be assigned.
- The difficulty getting chaperones for events was also mentioned. This is a PTSA issue. Tricia will pass the message along to Mike Karel.

OLD BUSINESS
