2. Athletic Dept. Report (C. Goddard for S. Amos)
Lacrosse Playoffs (Boys and Girls) at WJHS on Saturday evening, 5/14.
Powderpuff Game was great, Juniors won.
3. Flea Market Report (C. Goddard for S. Amos)
Will be held this Saturday, 5/14 rain or shine.
About 30 spaces sold to date.
Having problems getting signs posted in school.
Sue Amos will arrive by 6:00 am, set-up starts at 6:30.
Need a few more volunteers, especially early. A. Postar is arranging for Seniors who need SSL hours to help.
There will be a walk-a-thon on the track, which may generate more traffic.
4. Administration Report (C. Goddard)
Violence episodes last week (W-F) were stopped; involving non-WJHS students (all have received "no trespass" letters and are being disciplined at their schools); discipline at WJ included 2 suspensions; the "follow up" violence on Thursday and Friday was a bigger issue, very disruptive; mediation on Friday.
Enrollment is steadily rising.

\$10,315 + Woodward Relay concessions (~\$5,400) + Flea Mkt registrations (~\$1000) expenses not paid for yet: Spring sports awards, Booster Blue Sheet (\$600).

Running this as a separate fundraiser because of the large amount needed. Hopefully we can expand this into a corporate sponsorship drive to provide continuing income from outside the WJHS family.
\$1300 from WJ parents.
\$1600 from Marriott basketball players who rent gym.
