DESCRIPTION: The It's Academic Team is competing in two national tournaments at the end of the year: the NAQT tournament in Chicago, and the PACE tournament at George Mason University in Fairfax. The team has raised enough money to pay for the entire Chicago trip, including the tournament fee, the airline tickets, and the hotel accommodations. We are asking for some help with the other event: the PACE tournament fee is \$475.

HISTORY: We have made similar requests in the past few years, but I do not have that specific information.

OTHERDESCR: Tournament fee for the 2009 PACE National Championship at George Mason University in Fairfax.

TOTCOST: \$475

GRCONTR: We have done several concession stand events, including one coming up next week (4/30 lacrosse game).

GRFUNDING: We have raised enough money to pay for our entire trip to Chicago, including the airfare (\$1333), the hotel (\$400), and the tournament fee (\$525). The total for this came to over \$2250. This was done through:

1. We ran a small academic tournament in the fall for local teams and charged an entry fee.
2. We ran a much larger tournament for a full Saturday back in February for 32 teams; the tournament fee went into our account.
3. The team sponsor Mr. Whipple is the commissioner of the Montgomery Academic Beltway League, and the league dues for all 24 teams (\$35 per team) are deposited into our account.

OTHERFUNDING: In past years, the TV show "It's Academic" would give a contribution for appearing on the show; alas, this funding was drastically cut back two years ago.
