Level II (Orange)	Corrective Responses -Level II
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arguing w/ teachers or talking back • Poor attitude/rudeness • Chronic socializing w/ peers • Inappropriate language/ tone • Inappropriate hand gestures • Lying • Teasing and name calling • Leaving classroom without permission 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stop & Think prompt • Think chair • 10 mins. loss of recess • Write an action plan or reflection • Letter to parent-written by student
Level III (Red)	Corrective Responses-Level III
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stealing • Vandalism to school property • Physical aggression • Spitting • Bullying/verbally threatening behavior • Cheating 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stop & Think prompt • Think chair • Loss of recess • Replace or repair damaged items • Sent to office • Parent communication/ conference
Level IV	Corrective Responses-Level IV
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Throwing furniture • Hazardous behaviors/safety • Fighting • Sexual harassment or sexually inappropriate behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Office referral • Suspension • Parent call/conference
