INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIORS AND CORRECTIVE RESPONSES

Level I (Yellow)	Corrective Responses-Level I
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Name calling• Bouncing in seat/changing seat	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stop & Think prompt• Visual/non-verbal/physical prompt• Redirect
Level II (Orange)	Corrective Responses-Level II
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Yelling out of the window• Eating on the bus• Head/arm hanging out of bus window	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stop & Think prompt• Visual/non-verbal/ physical prompt• Redirect• 10 minute loss of recess• Report to adult on bus duty
Level III (Red)	Corrective Responses-Level III
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cursing• Spitting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stop & Think prompt• Visual/non-verbal/ physical prompt• Redirect• Loss of recess• Report to adult on bus duty
Level IV	Corrective Responses-Level IV
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fighting• Vandalism to bus	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete MCPS referral form• Report to adult on bus duty• Parents notified

POSITIVE BEHAVIORS AND INCENTIVES

Positive Bus Behaviors

- Listen/ Follow directions of bus driver
- Show respect for others and their property
- Sit in seat or remain seated at all times
- Using inappropriate level/tone of voice
- Arms and head remain inside of the bus
