Local School Objective #1: By the year 2011, Wootton High School students will demonstrate increased academic achievement by :

- a) Increasing scores on the PSAT from 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> grades, and increasing scores on the SAT in twelfth grade from year to year.
- b) Increase enrollment of students meeting college rigorous standards.

*The technology committee looked at how Wootton High School provides access to computer technology for student learning, practice and use of educational software*

*The student's access to computers and technological tools provide multiple modalities of obtaining, processing and demonstrating mastery of content specific objectives. This will help students to successfully complete advance courses to meet college rigorous standards.*

**Describe how the necessary resources will be committed to ensure the success of the action plan.**

*Each classroom is equipped with at least two computers for student use. Students have access to seven computer labs with at least 32 computers in each lab. The media center is fully equipped with 32 computer workstations. The ratio of computers to students is roughly 3.46 students per computer. All of the computers are networked through a client to provide access to each student through a secured user login and password.*
