MEDICARE and YOUR MCPS RETIREMENT HEALTH BENEFITS

Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) requires all participants in the MCPS Retiree Benefit plan to enroll in Medicare Parts A & B when first eligible. When you become Medicare-eligible, Medicare becomes your primary medical coverage and the MCPS medical plan becomes your Medicare supplement.

You are eligible for Medicare if you:

- Are age 65 and over,
- Receive social security disability benefits (from the Social Security Administration) and are beginning the
 25th month of entitlement, or
- Have certain medical conditions.

Your Medicare-eligibility date is the first day of the month in which you turn 65 if you have not qualified for enrollment before age 65. If your date of birth is the first of the month, the Medicare-eligibility date is the first of the previous month.

<u>NOTE:</u> Failure to enroll in Medicare Parts A & B when eligible will result in the termination of MCPS medical and prescription plans.
