UNIQUE FEATURES

- A school-based Wellness Center (SBWC) is included in the addition project. The SBWC staff provides somatic and mental health and case management services, youth development programs, and activities for students and families of the school community.
- The addition also features spaces for a Medical Careers Academy, a technology suite, and a special education suite.
- The stadium field has been upgraded with new artificial turf.
- The practice field has been upgraded with new Bermuda grass and an irrigation system.
- New tennis courts are located on top of a new elevated parking structure.
