## **Bookshare for Home Use**

MCPS staff can help eligible students get a free home use Bookshare account as long as they are already listed as a member in the organizational account through their school. Bookshare files on a PC need text reader software to read the file. The student will have to download and install a free text reader from <u>Bookshare</u> before being able to read a downloaded book.

Step 1: Log into your Bookshare account and click on "My Organization" and then "Members"

Step 2: Check off the student's name



Step 3: Select Individual Membership Form

Step 4: A PDF will be created with the student's name and birthdate

**Step 5:** Print the PDF form and give it to the parent to complete the following information:

- ➢ Home Email Address
- Home Address
- Student Name and Signature
- Parent Name and Signature

**Step 6:** Ask the parent to return the form to you. Scan and email the form to Bookshare as an attachment to <a href="mailto:membership@bookshare.org">membership@bookshare.org</a>. **Do not fax the completed membership form to the fax number on the form.** The response from Bookshare is much more reliable when the form is emailed to them.

Hint: To track your email In Outlook, select the Options tab. Click the box next to Request a Delivery Receipt and Request a Read Receipt.

Bookshare should send the parent a username and password within 2 business days. If not, then you can contact Membership services at 650-352-0198.
