Ease of Access


Students enter the door of your classroom with a range of learning strengths and needs (barriers). "The Ease of Access Center is a central location that you can use to set up the accessibility settings and

programs available in Windows. In the Ease of Access Center, you'll find quick access for setting up the accessibility settings and programs included in Windows."

Part 1: Locating the Ease of Access Center

On MCPS computers, you can open the Ease of Access Center by:

- 1) Olick on Windows Start
- 2) Select All Programs
- 3) Select "Accessories" or "Windows Accessories"
- 4) Select Ease of Access Center or;
- 1) Click on Windows Start ©
- 2) Click on the Control Panel
- 3) Click on the Ease of Access Center
