I. Issue: A need for more bilingual staff in the Wheaton cluster schools

II. Issue: A crossing guard is needed at the intersections of Goodhill Road and Weller Road for the safety of the students

Response by Dr. Frank Stetson: Crossing guards are a result of discussions with the

transportation and police departments

Dr. Stetson will ask the transportation department to investigate this matter.

III. Issue: There should be training implemented for school bus drivers in how to treat children with respect

Response by Dr. Frank Stetson: The school bus drivers are currently going through training on how to treat children better. This is a top priority for the community. It is an ongoing process.

IV. Issue: The Wheaton HS students need better sports uniforms

Response by Dr. Frank Stetson: The uniforms are rotated over a period of time, all of the sports teams are involved in the rotations. (ex. the basketball team will get new uniforms one year and another year the soccer team will get new uniforms) Schools that have more athletic revenue can make the uniform rotations faster.

Dr. Stetson will look into the Wheaton HS uniform matter.

V. Issue: There should be more alternatives to suspension of Wheaton HS students (ex. The "Sharp" Program) so they do not see suspension as a vacation

Response by Dr. Frank Stetson: The "Sharp" suspension program was in effect at Wheaton HS, however it was removed because of the small number of students taking advantage of the program. There was difficulty with parents not being able to admit their students to the program.

<u>Dr. Stetson will look into getting the program re-implemented at Wheaton HS and having the "Sharp" volunteers placed at the high school instead of local churches, so the program can be easily accessible to students.</u>

VII. Issue: Give academically challenged students more opportunities to take part in school sports as an incentive to improve their grades

Response by Dr. Frank Stetson: The Board of Education's policy is that students

must have at least a 2.0 grade point average to participate in athletic programs. This issue was recently reviewed by the Board of Education, who

decided to renew this policy

There is one exception; new 9th grade students coming in from middle school do not have this requirement until after the first quarter of their 9th

grade year.
