








What are the Student Requirements for SSL?

- MCPS students must complete
 75 SSL hours for graduation
- MCPS students may begin to earn SSL hours the <u>summer after completing</u> grade 5
- Students continue to earn hours throughout middle and high school

How do students earn 75 SSL hours?

Specific Academic Courses

- Grade 6 Science (10 hours)
- Grade 7 English (10 hours)
- Grade 8 Social Studies (10 hours)
- High School Class National, State, and Local (NSL) Government (15 hours)

Non-Profit Agencies

- Approved SSL opportunities with MCPS SSL Organizations through the Montgomery County Volunteer Center (MCVC) website
- Submit MCPS Form 560-50 for approval to serve with a non-profit agency that is not an MCPS SSL organization (https://bit.ly/SSLPreApproval)

45 Total Hours for In-School Classes

30 Total Hours from Outside of School

All Community SSL Activities Must be Pre-Approved

Listed as pre-approved on the Montgomery County Volunteer Center website, www.montgomeryserves.org

Organizations and opportunities that meet MCPS SSL guidelines are identified with a graduation cap icon. Hours from these organizations are approved.



Pre-approved with MCPS Form 560-50 confirmed in advance by the SSL coordinator <u>https://bit.ly/SSLPreApproval</u>

All community SSL activities are:

- During lunch or outside of the school day
- For a non-profit agency
- Not religious in nature
- In a public place
- Supervised (not by a parent or relative)
- For volunteer only (not paid)
- For no more than 8 hours in a day

Pre-Approved Virtual/Remote MCPS SSL Opportunities Offered Until the End of the 2021-2022 School Year

Pre-Approved Virtual/Remote SSL activities must be:

- completed under the sponsorship of a nonprofit representative
- posted on <u>www.montgomeryserves.org</u> and tagged with the blue MCPS SSL banner and graduation cap icon MCPS SSL
- completed <u>through the summer of 2021 and until the end of the</u> 2021-2022 school year


MCPS Form 560-51: SSL Activity Verification Form https://bit.ly/SSLReflection

- Students will submit the form to their <u>middle</u> <u>school SSL Coordinator</u>.
- Summer SSL hours can be turned in at the start of the following school year.

- Used to obtain pre-approval prior to <u>service</u> with an organization <u>not listed</u> on <u>www.montgomeryserves.org</u>
- Submit to <u>ssl@mcpsmd.org</u> during the summer and the school SSL Coordinator during the school year


Earn Superintendent's SSL Award in Middle School
