<u>Step 1</u>: On the video clip screen under the Playback Settings link, click the check box next to "Enable Closed Captioning"

<u>Step 2</u>: Right-click the "cc" icon and download the .smi file into the same directory as the video.

<u>Step 3</u>: Open windows media player and at the top, click Play (menu)->Captions and Subtitles->On if Available.

<u>Step 4</u>: Double click the video and your downloaded video will play with Closed Captioning.
