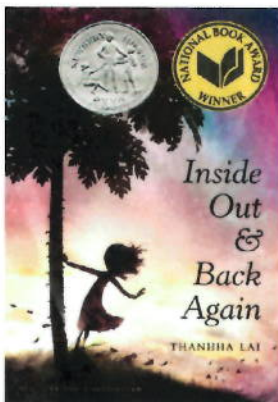

## The History of the Super Bowl

The Super Bowl is the sporting event that's most watched on television in America. Over 100 million people watch the game each year. Every year, the two champions from the two conferences in the NFL (the AFC and NFC) would face off in a nail biting, edge of your seat, nerve wracking game, to crown a champion. Each player from the winning team receives one gold ring studded with diamonds, and a lifetime of glory. Also, the Most Valuable Player (MVP) will be crowned after the game has concluded. Football fans come from all over the country, sometimes even if their team did not make it to the Super Bowl. To be at a Super bowl would be an amazing experience, no matter if your team is in it or not. Most football fans would do anything to get their hands on Super Bowl tickets, as the prices are extremely high.

In 1966, the National Football League's (NFL), commissioner, Pete Rozelle, and owner of the American Football League's (AFL), Kansas City Chiefs, Lamar Hunt, decided to make a merger agreement where the two leagues would join, and form one league in 1970. In the meantime, champions of the two conferences would play each other in one championship game at the end of the season. This game would determine a champion at the end of every season. While Hunt was viewing his daughter play with a super ball, an idea struck him! He thought that they should call the game the "Super Bowl". At first, Rozelle and Hunt both agreed that they would eventually be able to come up with a better name, but it stuck with the media, as the name was used in sporting articles before the inaugural game.

Finally, after four long years of waiting, Super Bowl I arrived. Back then tickets only costed \$12, but that was considered a boatload of money during that time. Today, one Super Bowl ticket would cost thousands of dollars! Super Bowl I was the only Super Bowl to not be sold out. The first Super Bowl was held at the Los Angeles Coliseum. The game featured the NFL's Green Bay Packers and the AFL's

Kansas City Chiefs. Nobody expected anything from the feeble AFL team. They guessed right, because the head coach of the Packers, Vince Lombardi, led his team to a 35-10 victory over the Chiefs. After he died in 1970, the World Professional Championship Trophy was renamed the "Vince Lombardi Trophy" in his honor. The winning team now receives this trophy.

Green Bay scored by producing 3 touchdowns in the second half. The first touchdown was contributed by safety Willie Wood, who had a 50-yard interception, that allowed the Packers to set up on the Chief's 5-yard line. Wide receiver Max McGee who, for the entire season was allowed a miniscule amount of only 4 catches, caught 7 for 138 yards and 2 touchdowns from Green Bay's quarterback Bart Starr. Elijah Pitts ran for 2 other touchdowns. The Kansas City Chief's 10 points came in the second quarter. They had one touchdown on a pass from quarterback Len Dawson to halfback Curtis McClinton, and a field goal by kicker Don Chandler. The Green Bay Packers won Super Bowl I, 35-10 against the Kansas City Chiefs!

Nowadays, every football team's players, coaches, and fans dream is for them to win a Super Bowl. Hopefully, the Super Bowl's legacy will be carried on for many years to come. Fans will still wear their team's spirit in the form of jerseys and hats. People will be pouring through the gate to get into the stadium to witness the historical game. Confetti will still pour down in the stadium, coating the ground. Trophies will still be held high in the air, so all can see. Winning players will still wear their rings with pride. And Super Bowl I will be remembered as the most important Super Bowl of all time.



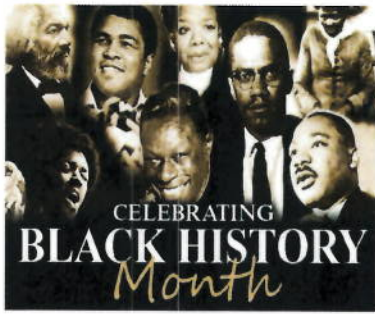
## Martin Luther King Jr
