

Tips for managing log-in time with netbooks:

- 1) by turning on the netbooks in advance, you can cut 60-90 seconds off the log-in time (updates are downloaded before students log-in)
- 2) plan to have students log-in and then establish routines to continue instruction as the log-in happens: tricks include having screen turned towards you (so you can see when they are logged in and students are not distracted), starting log-in and then placing netbook under seat, logging in and then closing netbooks so it goes into hibernate mode which will not take long to get back into
- 3) You may need to shut down completely for them to be charged: once the shutdown process is started by the student, the student can close the netbook, plug it in - it will eventually shut down and start charging. Waiting for this process can seem to take a long time so having them do this makes it manageable.
