## This month we...

Math: counted to 100 by 1s and 10 s, and solved put together story word problems using drawings, and decomposed up to 6 ..

Social Studies/ Science: identified landforms and bodies of water in the environment. Created shelters with a roof designed to keep water out.

Reading: determined important information, identified text features and story elements.

## Coming up next month...

Math: we will be describing, comparing, and composing shapes.
