Highland View Eagles have been soaring to new heights with their musical knowledge this past month.

- Kindergarten students are performing songs with long and short sounds. The students are also experimenting with a variety of classroom instruments and observing the sound qualities of specific families.
- 1st Grade students are reading and performing simple melodies (using sol and mi) and rhythms (using quarter and eighth notes).
- 2nd Grade students are using rhythm instruments and barred instruments to perform simple **accompaniments** for class songs.
- 3rd Grade students are discussing and demonstrating new vocabulary words for the *expressive elements* ... dynamics, tempo and articulation.
- 4th Grade students are discussing the elements of music specifically the element of **style**. The students are performing **spirituals**, and examining their use and meaning in history.
- 5th Grade students are listening for **major and minor tonalities** in musical selections and discussing how composers make choices in order to convey meaning and mood.
