I have really enjoyed seeing our returning students and getting to know all of our new Highland View musicians during the first few weeks of school. All students are off to a **ROARing** start in music this year ... especially the kindergartners who will be continuing to study different ways to use their *voices-talking*, *singing*, *whispering*, *and calling*. They have gotten lots of practice using their voices in different ways.

First grade students have been performing and listening for loud (forte) and soft (piano) dynamics.

Second graders have been showing expertise in singing songs with sol and mi patterns and then playing the songs on xylophones.

Third grade students have been learning about folk songs and performing folk songs that have cumulative form.

Fourth grade students have been identifying contrasting and repeating sections and phrases in music and have performed a Russian folk dance.

Fifth grade students have learned the definition of a musical chord and are working to perform chord accompaniments using the C chord, F chord and G chord.

All chorus rehearsals, grades 3-5, begin on Tuesday, October 1st.
