Update on curriculum supports

The Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention System (LLI) is an intensive, small-group, supplementary literacy intervention for students who find reading and writing difficult. The goal of LLI is to lift the literacy achievement of students who are not achieving grade-level expectations in reading. Because the LLI books are high-quality leveled books that captivate and engage students they are used with a variety of students at Monocacy, not just those students who are having difficulty. There are 144 different titles in an individual kit. MES had one kit already, but because the students were making such gains, there was a critical need for the second kit.
