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Math Olympiad

Math Olympiad is an international math program that meets weekly before school for 40 minutes. The program runs from October through mid-March fifteen weeks and is intended to introduce important math concepts, teach strategies for problem solving, strengthen mathematical intuition, foster mathematical creativity & ingenuity, develop mathematical flexibility in solving problems, and to stimulate enthusiasm and a love for mathematics. The students participate in 5 contests throughout the year. At the end of the year all students receive a certificate, and some may even earn a pin or patch depending on how many problems they get correct in each contest throughout the year.

We usually have 10 4th graders and 15 5th graders who are recommended by their teachers. We also look at Map scores along with a practice test.
