Dear Parents,

The temperatures lately suggest that winter has arrived! Even though technically, winter begins on December 21st, we have all had to pull out the winter coats as well as other cold weather gear. We wanted to update you on our procedures for colder weather here at Rockwell with regard to outdoor lunch and recess:

- ❖ We factor in the wind chill to determine the "feels like" temperature in making all decisions about indoor vs. outdoor recess and lunch
- ❖ If it "feels like" less than 32 degrees Fahrenheit, we choose to keep students indoors for both lunch and recess
- Students are never forced to eat outdoors; this is always a choice if the weather and ground conditions allow outdoor lunch
- ❖ We must be consistent with students for indoor vs. outdoor *recess* due to adult supervision requirements- all students either go out or stay in
- ❖ Indoor recess is held in the classroom and teachers have collected games and activities for students to do with friends in their classroom during the 40 minute recess time

Our teachers continue to take advantage of milder days to take students outside for a walk, to have a quick discussion, or even to do a short lesson. We will continue to do this as the weather conditions allow. This is a terrific break for students and Rockwell staffs.



Congratulations Kindergarten through Grade 5 teachers and Parent-Teacher parents! We hit the overall 90% parent/teacher conference held in November and early December! This is a true testament to dedicated staff who worked around parent schedules and to committed parents who made the time to

talk with teachers either via telephone or on Zoom meetings about student progress and how they can help at home. Our Rockwell students are the beneficiaries of this attention to building a strong home/school connection. Bravo one and all!

Weekly COVID Testing Continues:

CIAN Diagnostics continues to visit Rockwell every Friday afternoon for COVID testing. Parents should be receiving negative results via email. We will continue to test on Friday afternoons. You can give permission for your child to be tested

weekly if you have not done so already. Please log into Parent Vue and search for COVID testing. If you experience difficulty, please call the school and seek assistance from Mrs. Nelson or Mr. Isabell.

What if your child is sick? Have you considered becoming an MCPS Substitute?

MCPS is seeking substitute teachers! Substitute teaching is an excellent way to learn about our schools while allowing principals and teachers to get to know you. To qualify as a substitute teacher, each applicant must present proof of the completion of the minimum of an associate's degree or 60 college credits from an accredited institution.

Substitute teachers are temporary employees and are on an on call basis. An automated substitute calling system helps you manage your work schedule by allowing you to call at any time, day or night, to find jobs. This system is telephone and internet accessible. The system uses your subject area and location preferences to offer you jobs on the days you have selected and allows you to change the days you work.

Substitute Teacher Rates: Daily hourly rate of pay \$18.79- Long Term rate \$26.81.

If you hold a valid Maryland professional eligibility certificate or standard advanced professional certificate, the daily hourly rate of pay is \$19.97-Long Term rate \$28.45. In order to qualify for this higher rate of pay, you must submit a copy of your valid Maryland certificate.

Beginning October 2021, all school volunteers and partnering agencies will be required to complete an additional new module via their *myMCPS Classroom/Canvas* account called **COVID-19 Vaccination Attestation** in order to volunteer within our school district. Currently, all volunteers/contractors must complete the vCAN (Volunteer Child Abuse/Neglect) module. In addition, depending on level of volunteering, some are required to be fingerprinted, per the vCAN FAQ. Fingerprinting requirements are not being changed. The new module will consist of a volunteer a) attesting to being fully vaccinated, b) uploading their *Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination* from the Maryland Department of Health, and c) agreeing to specific expectations of masking and social distancing while in MCPS facilities.

User-Guides on how to access both module requirements and how to access and upload their *Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination* from the Maryland Department of Health will be available on the Child Abuse and Neglect and the <u>Volunteers websites</u>.
