Unfortunately, we do not have space in our cafeteria for parents to eat lunch with students.

All visitors for Open House (visits to classrooms) will need to check in at the office and use our Visitor Management System which requires a state issued identification card (i.e. driver's license). Visiting classrooms does **not** require you to be cleared as a volunteer since you are only observing in classrooms.

We will begin checking parents in for Open House at 8:45 AM (before the flag raising ceremony) and continue with check-ins until 9:30 AM. After check-in, parents will wait in the lobby and/or outside to participate in the flag-raising ceremony at 9:30 AM. We will resume checking additional parents in at 10:00 AM when the flag raising ceremony is over. Parent visitors will accompany students back to class following the ceremony if desired. Please bring your ID into the office and we will have assistants to help with the check-in process. After checking in, you will be issued a visitor badge which is required for the duration of your visit. We ask that you check-out in the office by scanning your visitor's sticker prior to leaving for the day.



Lunch at Rockwell

Our district portions food for school lunches and breakfasts based on recommendations from the National School Lunch Program. Lunches served in our cafeteria provide one-third of the recommended levels for key nutrients. Meals are distributed one per student through purchase or our Free/Reduced lunch program. This year, we do not plan for students to have

access to more than one meal per person. If you believe your child needs additional food, please consider sending in additional healthy food items that can be eaten with the school lunch. Children will not have access to second helpings of anything on the lunch tray from the cafeteria.

Air Conditioning to Heat Conversion Coming Up!

Rockwell will undergo its conversion to heat from A/C next week. It's always important for students to dress in layers and for the weather. Once the A/C is turned off, it will not be back on until the Spring. Heat is set in MCPS buildings at 68 degrees. Short sleeved shirts with sweaters or sweatshirts make for the flexibility that your child may need to stay comfortable in classes.
