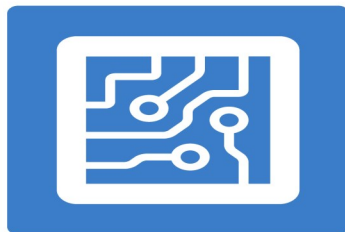
The **elementary program**, “Water, Water Everywhere: Designing Water Filters,” introduces students to the problem of water pollution—and to solutions. Students will investigate the properties of filter materials, use their knowledge, and think like engineers as they plan, construct, test and improve their own water filters.

Kids in the **middle school program**, “Go Fish: Engineering Prosthetic Tails,” will plan and design prosthetic devices — a model leg for an elephant and a model beak for an eagle.

The program at both levels promotes creativity and teamwork! At the end of the program, students show what they’ve learned at the final program showcase.



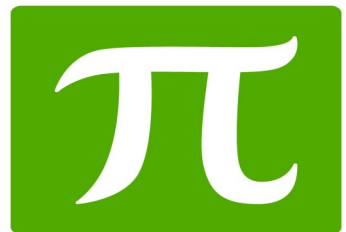
