<u>Up Next:</u>

Math: We will be ending our third module in the middle of the month. Students have been learning about three digit numbers and that they are made up of different amounts of hundreds, tens, and ones. Students have worked with bundling ones, tens, and hundreds to make a larger unit, writing and reading numbers in expanded form, word form, and standard form. We will finish out the module by comparing three digit numbers before moving into module four. Module four focuses on building fluency in two-digit addition and subtraction within 100 and applying that fluency to one and two step word problems.

Reading: We began our second unit in reading where we are focusing on fiction stories and the question "What can we learn when we face problems?" Students will recount story events, determine the central message, describe how characters respond to major events and challenges, and compare and contrast different versions of the same story.

Phonics: With our HD Words lessons, we will be focusing on reading words with vowel teams. Vowel teams are letters that go together that make a long vowel sounds such as: **ai**, **ay**, **ee**, **ea**, **oa**, **ow**, **igh**, **ie**, and **ey**. At the end of the month, we will be focusing on reading words that have a controlled r sound. Examples are : **ar**, **or**, **our**, **oor**, **ore**, and **oar**.

Writing: With our new reading unit comes a new writing project. Students will be learning all about personal narratives as they write their own. Students will learn to embed phonics and conventions of English into their writing. These include: irregular verbs, adverbs, and reflexive pronouns.

Social Studies: Students spent the last few weeks
