| Reading/Language Arts <br> Students will: <br> * Retell stories, including key details. <br> * Describe characters, setting, and major events in a story using key details. | Writing <br> Students will: <br> * Create a topic list and choose a topic to write a narrative, including 2 or more sequenced events. Include drawings that demonstrate character's thoughts and feelings. <br> * Demonstrate the ability to use proper end punctuation. |
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| Math <br> Students will: <br> * Count by Is and $\mathrm{I} \mathrm{Os}_{\mathrm{s}}$ to I 20 (including one more and one less). <br> * Read and write numerals to 120 . <br> * Understand that the 2 digits of a 2 -digit number represent amounts of tens and ones. <br> * Compare 2-digit numbers based on the meanings of the tens and ones digits and use $\ggg$, or $=$ to record the comparisons. <br> * Given a 2 -digit number, mentally find 10 more or 10 less than the number, without having to count, explain the reasoning used. | Social Studies and Science <br> * In Social Studies, students will be able to explain how ground rules promote fairness, responsibility and privacy. They will also be able to identify home, school and community responsibilities. <br> * In Science, students will study the basic needs of plants and animals in our environment. |
