Reading/Language Arts

Students will:

- * Retell stories, including key details.
- Describe characters, setting, and major events in a story using key details.



Writing

Students will:

- Create a topic list and choose a topic to write a narrative, including 2 or more sequenced events. Include drawings that demonstrate character's thoughts and feelings.
- Demonstrate the ability to use proper end punctuation.



Math


Students will:

- Count by Is and IOs to I20 (including one more and one less).
- * Read and write numerals to 120.
- ❖ Understand that the 2 digits of a 2-digit number represent amounts of tens and ones.
- Compare 2-digit numbers based on the meanings of the tens and ones digits and use >, >, or = to record the comparisons.
- ❖ Given a 2-digit number, mentally find 10 more or 10 less than the number, without having to count, explain the reasoning used.



Social Studies and Science

- In Social Studies, students will be able to explain how ground rules promote fairness, responsibility and privacy. They will also be able to identify home, school and community responsibilities.
- ❖ In *Science*, students will study the basic needs of plants and animals in our environment.
