

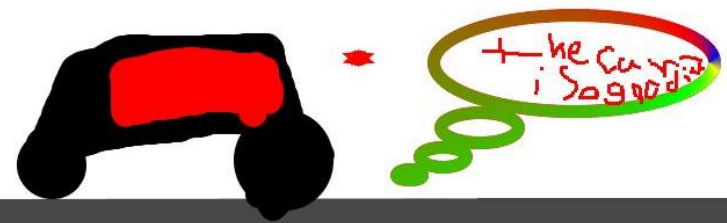

I'm like Henry Ford because I'm a good inventer and I like cars too. I show persistence when I keep on trying new ideas when I invent things like stadiums and lacrosse

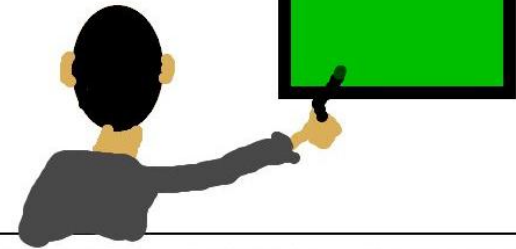

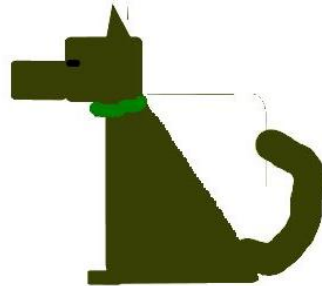

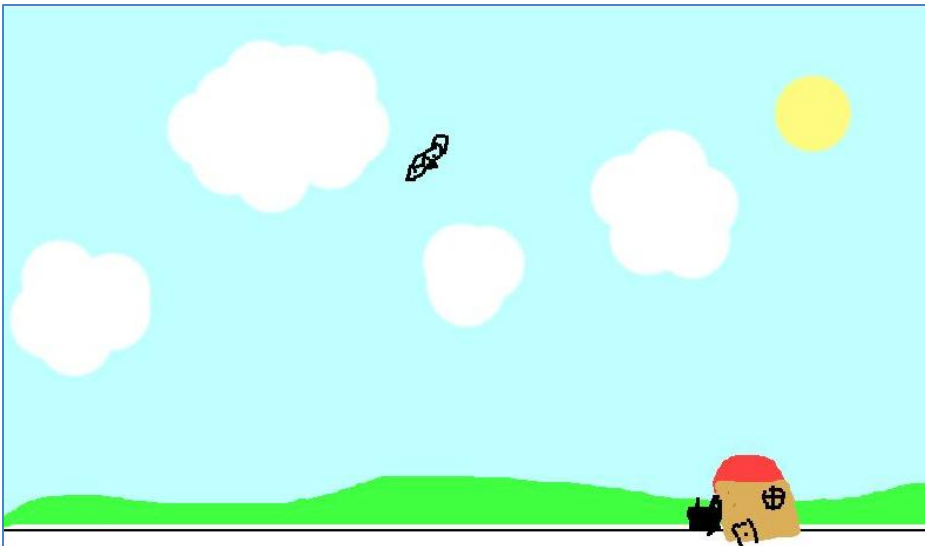
Amelia Earhart

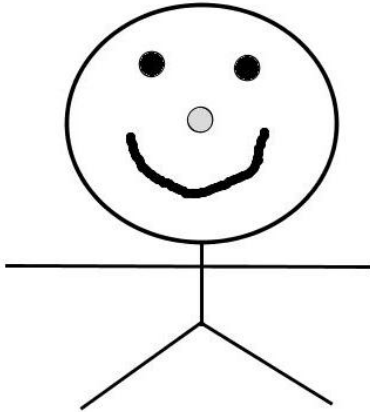
Jimmy Carter

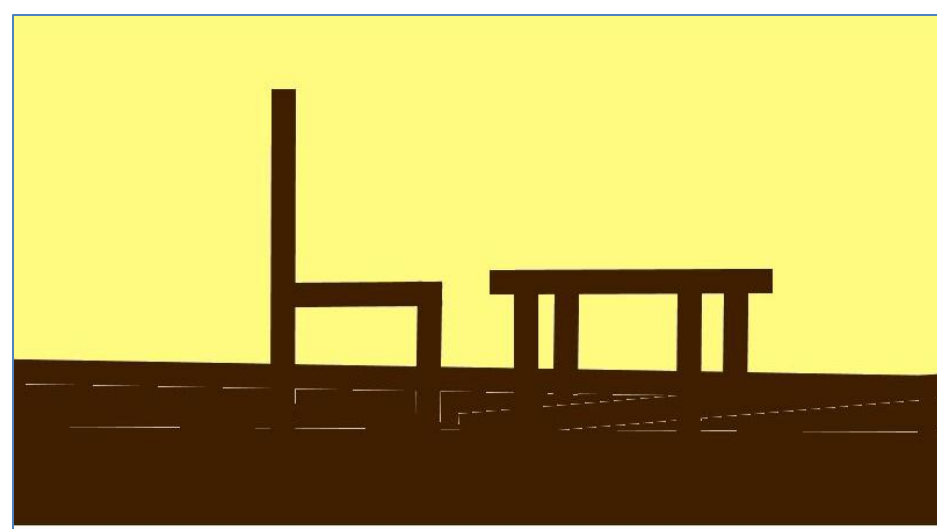

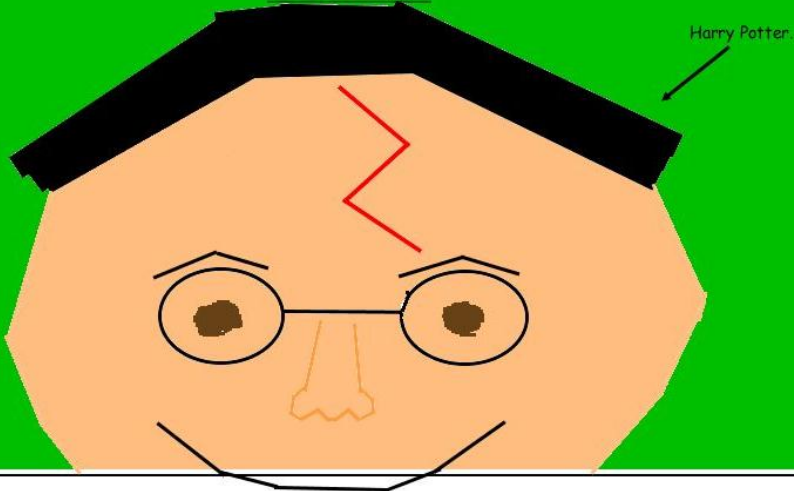


Joanne Rowling was born on July 31, 1965 in Yate England. Joanne Rowling is famous for writing the first Harry Potter books.

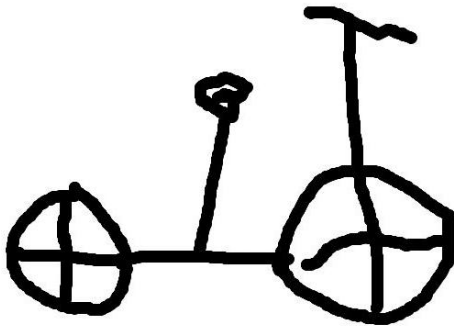
Christopher Columbus

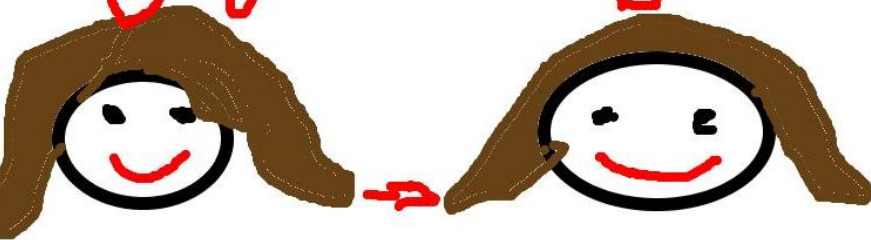

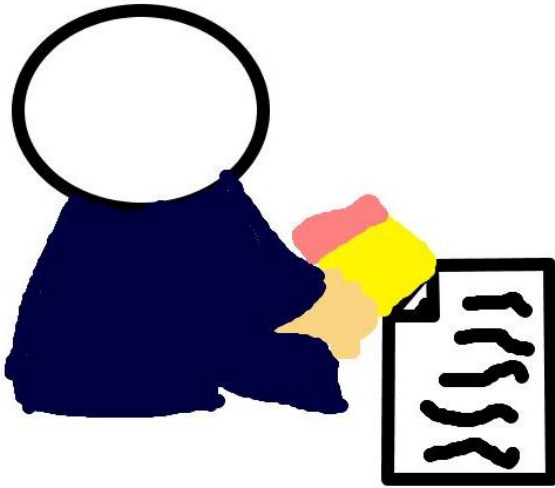
Roald Dahl by Timmy
