7:00 a.m. Depart from Roberto Clemente Middle School aboard two deluxe, restroom-equipped motor coaches.

10:00 a.m. Arrive in Philadelphia and meet your tour guides in front of the National Constitution Center at
525 Arch Street. You will have 4 tour guides in Philadelphia.

Begin an exciting walking tour of historic Philadelphia, featuring the famed Liberty Bell, our nation's most honored symbol of liberty and additional historic attractions as time allows.

11:15 a.m. During your visit at the National Constitution Center, view a film and extensive exhibits showcasing the significance of the U.S. Constitution. Learn how the Constitution shapes our daily lives and protects our rights and freedoms as Americans.

Continue narrated walking tour as time allows.

2:45 p.m. Group assembles (based on entry time) to prepare to enter Independence Hall for a National Park Service-led interior tour. **Reserved time for up to 60 group members is at 3:00. The rest of the group may enter at 3:15.**

4:00 p.m. Depart Philadelphia for return trip.

Enjoy a brief meal and rest stop in route home.

8:00 p.m. Arrive at Robert Clemente Middle School.
