# There is still time to earn the optional Superintendent Award for the 2023-2024 school year!

Any middle school student who has submitted completely filled out SSL Verification forms to show the completion of the 75-hour SSL high school graduation requirement (for the first time in middle school) by April 5, 2024, will receive the optional Superintendent's SSL Award. No application or other form is required to earn the Superintendent's SSL Award. The 10 SSL hours students may potentially earn through grade 8 social studies class do NOT count towards the Superintendent Award. For students who earned the grade-level curriculum 10 SSL hours, the MCPS SSL office will process hours during the summer. If you are currently in 6th or 7th grade you have until early April of your 8th-grade year to earn the Superintendent Award.



# **Course-Embedded SSL Hours - Full Year**

Thirty SSL hours may be earned through full participation in middle school courses:

- Counts towards the Superintendent Award
  - Grade 6 science (Outdoor Education), 10 hours
  - Grade 6 English for ELs (formerly known as ESOL), 10 hours
  - Grade 7 English, 10 hours
  - Grade 7 English for ELs (formerly known as ESOL), 10 hours
- Does NOT count towards the Superintendent Award
  - Grade 8 social studies, 10 hours
  - Grade 8 English for ELs (formerly known as ESOL), 10 hours

SSL coordinators should NOT add any course-based SSL hours to Synergy, hours will be added during the summer to students' SSL records for students who complete the service-learning project.
