### **Board of Education Seeks Applicants to Fill Position on Ethics Panel**

ROCKVILLE, MD – The Montgomery County Board of Education is seeking to fill one vacancy on its five-member Ethics Panel. The vacancy is for a three-year term beginning on July 1, 2017. Members serve without compensation.

As noted in Board Policy, BBB, [Ethics](#), among the Panel's responsibilities are: (1) approving financial disclosure forms; (2) interpreting the Board of Education's Ethics Policy and issuing advisory opinions concerning its application; and (3) conducting hearings on complaints filed regarding an alleged violation.

Panel members may not be incumbent members of the Board of Education, school officials, employees, or persons employed by a business entity subject to the authority of the Board of Education, or spouses of such persons. The Panel meets once a year to review financial disclosure forms and as needed to review complaints and requests for advisory opinions.

Applicants must submit a letter of interest along with a resumé or other documentation to support the application by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 26, 2017, for the appointment to be made at the Board meeting on June 13, 2017. (Applicants are not required to attend this meeting.)
