June 26 – 29 & July 31 – Aug. 3 **Automotive Tech & Collision/Repair**
Gaithersburg High School – 8:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

Automotive Technology - Get your hands dirty working on cars in your spare time. Do oil changes, operate and safely use shop equipment like a lift, air tools, learn basic electrical principles, and perform brake services.

Auto Body Collision and Repair - Repair a little scratch or ding in a car; erase imperfections of a car's appearance. Learn how to repair a small dent, apply and sand primer, and then repaint the repaired panel. Also engage in detailing the interior and exterior of a car in order to prepare it for retail sale.
