OVERVIEW

The Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Regional Elementary Summer School Programs offer enrichment and reinforcement activities for current elementary school students. Students must register at their grade level in 2013–2014.

ELIGIBILITY

- Only for students who are currently enrolled in Grades K through 5 in the 2013–2014 school year.
- Students entering kindergarten this coming fall are not eligible.
- Incoming Grade 6 students should contact their local middle school about the Middle School Extended Year program.

 MCPS ID number. Checks drawn on foreign banks will not be accepted.
- No registrations will be accepted after June 20, 2014.
- No confirmation will be mailed. You will be contacted only if a class has been cancelled.
- Credit/debit card payments (VISA or MasterCard only) must be made online at http://osp.osmsinc.com/MontgomeryMD/. When the application is received, an e-mail message will be sent with detailed instructions on how to pay online. A valid e-mail address must be included in the registration form. Once payment is received, the student will be registered for summer school.
- Please print a receipt for your records.

TUITION WAIVER (Form is located at www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/departments/extendedhours/summerschool/)

- Students may qualify for reduced tuition.
- To apply, complete and attach MCPS Form 325-4: Application for Partial or Full Waiver of Summer School Tuition and supporting documents.

REFUNDS (Form is located at www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/departments/extendedhours/summerschool/)

- Full refunds will be made if a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.
- Full refunds will be made to students who never attended a class.
- Partial refunds will be made to students who attend class for one week or less. Exceptions
 will be made for students who attend class less than one week and must withdraw
 because of hospitalization or home confinement for personal illness.
- No refunds will be made to students who attend class for more than one week.
- No refunds will be made if a student is suspended or expelled from summer school.
- The deadline to request a refund is August 1, 2014.
- Refunds may take up to eight weeks.

REPORT CARDS

Students will receive a written report on the last day of school.
