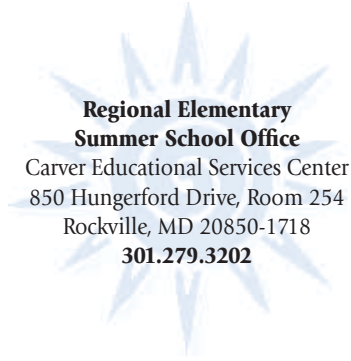

OVERVIEW

The Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Regional Elementary Summer School Programs offer enrichment and reinforcement activities for current elementary school students. Students must register at their grade level in 2015–2016.

ELIGIBILITY

- Only for students who are currently enrolled in Grades K through 5 in the 2015–2016 school year.
- Students entering kindergarten this coming fall are not eligible.

REGISTRATION *(Form is located at www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/departments/extendedhours/summerschool/)*

- Select **TWO** courses from the list below and indicate those on the registration form.
- **MAIL** completed registration forms and appropriate payment (check and money orders, must be attached) to:

- Checks or money orders should be made payable to MCPS. Checks must be preprinted with name and address or they will be returned. Include the student's name and MCPS ID number. Checks drawn on foreign banks will not be accepted.
- No registrations will be accepted after June 20, 2016.
- Mail-in Deadline: Postmarked by June 17, 2016.
- No confirmation will be mailed. **You will be contacted only if a class has been cancelled.**
- **Credit/debit card payments** (VISA or MasterCard only) must be made online at <http://osp.osmsinc.com/MontgomeryMD/>. A valid e-mail address must be included on the registration form. When the application is received, an e-mail message will be sent with detailed instructions on how to pay online. **Once payment is received, the student will be registered for summer school.** Please print a receipt for your records.

TUITION WAIVER *(Form is located at www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/departments/extendedhours/summerschool/)*

- Students may qualify for reduced tuition.
- To apply, complete and attach MCPS Form 325-4: *Application for Partial or Full Waiver of Summer School Tuition*, and supporting documents.

REFUNDS *(Form is located at www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/departments/extendedhours/summerschool/)*

- Full refunds will be made if a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.
- Full refunds will be made to students who never attended a class.
- Partial refunds will be made to students who attend class for the first week or less. Exceptions will be made for students who attend class less than one week and must withdraw because of hospitalization or home confinement for personal illness.
- No refunds will be made to students who attend class for more than the first week.
- No refunds will be made if a student is suspended or expelled from summer school.
- The deadline to request a refund is July 8, 2016.
- Refunds may take up to eight weeks.

REPORT CARDS

Students will receive a written report on the last day of school.
