



Title I Summer Program Volunteers

What you need to know!

What programs may a student volunteer for?

All three Title I summer programs, Extended Learning Opportunities Summer Adventures in Learning(ELO SAIL), Extended Learning Opportunities Summer Title I Enrichment Program (ELO STEP), and the Building Educational Leaders for Life program (BELL) are accepting volunteer applications.

What are the dates of the program?

All programs will take place from July 9th until August 10th.

How will a student be able to sign-up as a volunteer?

Volunteer opportunities will be posted on the Montgomery County Volunteer Center's website. The link can be found here. Each summer program site will have a cap on the number of volunteers that can register. Volunteers will only be able to sign up for one summer program site on a first come, first serve basis. Volunteers will need a teacher, a school counselor, and an administrator at their home school to sign off that they are in good standing to volunteer as part of the application process.

Can a volunteer pick a specific program they want to volunteer in?

No, student's will be placed in one of the specific programs listed above based on need and availability at the site they selected.

Will there be an orientation at the school prior to the start of the program?

Yes, each school site will have a volunteer orientation on June 28, 2018. Administrators at each site will determine the time of the meetings.

Can volunteers ride the bus to and from the Title I summer programs?

Yes, but only student volunteers may ride the bus. The student volunteer is responsible for getting to the neighborhood bus stop in the AM and returning home in the PM.

Will volunteers receive meals during the day?

Yes, volunteers age 18 and under will receive breakfast and lunch, daily, free of charge.
