

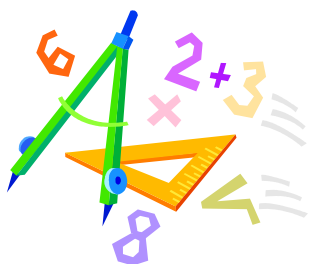

# ACTIVITIES OVERVIEW

Banneker Middle School offers students an assortment of after school activities, clubs and teams. After school activities will begin on **Tuesday, October 4, 2011 from 2:50 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.** The program will run on most Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Students should notify their parents at least a day in advance that they are staying for the after school program.

Transportation is available for students who regularly ride a bus and participate in the After School Activities Program. Generally, we offer after school activity buses Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. There are no activity buses on Mondays or Fridays, or the day before and sometimes after a major holiday. **Buses for athletic teams are separate from the activity buses that depart at 4:15 p.m.** There are NO sports buses on game days. General information, rules, and schedules are included in this guidebook. A list of clubs and activities will be available through a monthly calendar that will be sent home at the beginning of each month. Students should also listen for announcements for club information and updates.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS



- Attending the after-school program is a privilege, not a right.
- Students must be at the scheduled activity by 2:50 p.m.
- Students who participate in the ASA program are not allowed to go out of the building, including the bus loading area, after the 2:40 p.m. dismissal bell.
- Students suspended from school may not participate in the ASA program on the days that they are suspended.
- Students who do not complete homework or class work during the school day, may only participate in homework club for that day.
- Attendance will be taken and sent to the after school coordinator.
- If a student is late, he/she may not be permitted to attend the activity and may be sent to after-school detention.
- Students are not to be in the halls without a pass from the supervisor of the activity. Chronic hall walkers will be suspended from the after school program.
- Students in the hallways without a pass may also be sent to after-school detention.
- Not following the rules may result in the loss of after school privileges.

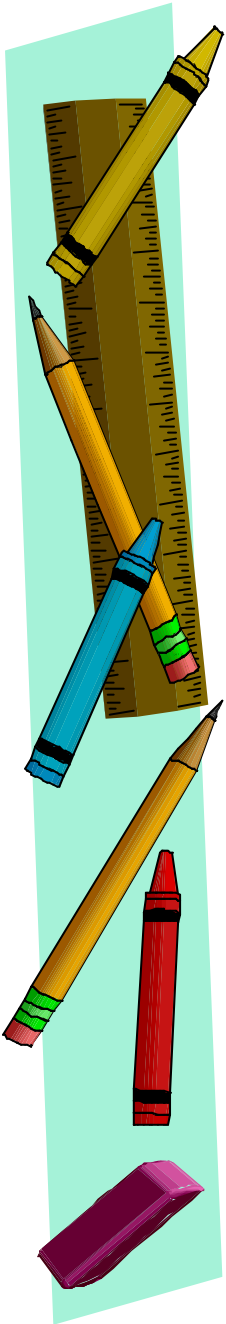
