Curriculum Notes

Literature: This month, we will read a variety of stories about wind and the transition into spring. We will read several St. Patrick's Day stories, and continue reading stories by Rosemary Wells. We will emphasize text features in informational texts as well as comprehension.

Reading: The children will continue to work on reading strategies and comprehension skills in guided reading groups. They will identify events that occur in the beginning, middle and end of stories. Once again, we emphasize the importance of reading nightly with your child.

Math: We will continue with our measurement unit and learning about 2-D and 3-D shapes. We will learn to recognize objects with 3-D geometric shapes, such as an ice cream cone, ball, etc.

Writing: We will continue Writer's Workshop and journal writing. The children will continue writing to inform through the use of informational text.

Science: We will continue working on our science curriculum about plants and animals. We will identify and label plants, animals, and their external features.

Social Studies: We will learn about natural resources and how they are used to provide goods and services to our world.
