**Gaithersburg 2**

The Barons (4-1-2) wrapped up their third game of the week with a resounding win over the visiting Gaithersburg Trojans (2-3). B-CC brought pressure early and it took only 5 minutes for the Barons to find the back of the net with Luc Sebrechts nodding in a long throw-in from Stephen Sawicki from deep on the left side. The advantage was short lived however, as Gaithersburg took advantage of B-CC's failure to clear a corner kick and the Trojans equalized the score in the 18<sup>th</sup> minute. The Barons were quick to respond with a nice combination down the right side with Collin Martin picking out Cy McNeill on an overlapping run. Cy in turn delivered a perfect cross for Luis Tineo to head home his first goal of the season and a 2-1 advantage, which the Barons took to the half.

The second half was less than a minute old when Bradley Vorv sent a cross from deep on the right side to Collin, who calmly settled the ball and drilled home B-CC's third goal.

Gaithersburg featured several dangerous players and a lot of team speed, and they often pressed nine players forward on the attack. The aggressive strategy though left them vulnerable to counter attacks, which B-CC did well to exploit. Beautiful combination passing in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute between Bradley and Collin led to a tap-in goal for Collin and a 4-1 B-CC advantage. One minute later, the Trojans pounced on an unfortunate giveaway by the Barons deep in their own half to cut the advantage to 4-2.

B-CC struck again in the 59<sup>th</sup> minute when Bradley struck a beautiful through ball to Robert Palmer charging down the right flank. Robert took the ball in, then sent a well-timed cross to Collin who buried it in the back of the net to send the Barons up 5-2.

One minute later, Robert dispossessed a Trojan player near midfield, took the ball himself down the right side and fired a bullet from near the top of the box to put the Barons up 6-2.

The solid performance by the Barons allowed Coach Gui to go deep on his roster, with Coby Friedman, Ben Gold, Tim McKay, Noah Riskind, Jimmy Doll, Ben Alexander, Jake Elsey, Scott Bradley, Kyle Monsees, Dustin Spencer, Drake Clark, Cam Hoffman, and Jimmy Salisbury also contributing to the win.

B-CC next plays Tuesday at Springbrook.
