The Barons (2-1-2) started an action-packed week with their most complete performance thus far with a convincing 3-0 win over Wootton (4-2). The first half saw a flurry of shots from the Barons that went unrewarded. Finally, in the 38<sup>th</sup> minute, Cy McNeill's hard work down the right side ended with a connection to Collin Martin, who alertly crossed the ball into a well-positioned Freddie Nzekele. Freddie brought the ball down about 12 yards out and quickly fired a low shot past the keeper for his first goal of the season and a 1-0 advantage.

The Barons showcased their ball possession skills in the second half as long stretches passed without the Patriots even touching the ball. Collin, along with midfielders Noah Riskind, Ben Alexander, Jimmy Doll, and Robert Palmer, orchestrated control of the game. The back line of Cy, Jake Elsey, Stephen Sawicki, and Tim McKay, along with keeper Coby Friedman, were used effectively in possession and were resolute in thwarting Patriot counterattacks.

The Barons stylish play produced a second goal in the 58<sup>th</sup> minute when Ben switched the ball from the center of the pitch to Jimmy on the right side. Jimmy deftly controlled the pass and touched it through to Collin who calmly tapped the ball past the overmatched Wootton goalkeeper.

Collin tallied B-CC's third goal in the 77<sup>th</sup> minute with a well-struck penalty kick. The PK resulted from a clumsy challenge in the box by a Wootton defender after Collin had beaten the defender on the dribble.

Also contributing to the Barons' win were Bradley Vorv, Luc Sebrechts, Luis Tineo, Cam Hoffman, and Drake Clark.
