

Junior Year Calendar

September

- ✓ Register for the PSAT.
- ✓ Attend visits of college representatives in the College and Career Center (throughout the fall).

October

- ✓ Take the PSAT.

November

- ✓ Attend Prep for Test night.

December

- ✓ Receive results for the PSAT.
- ✓ Get personal code to sign up on Family Connection – establish username and password.
- ✓ Attend college information presentation in class, given by B-CC counselor.
- ✓ Attend “Alumni Panel” program.
- ✓ Plan on visiting local colleges during winter break to get a feel for the type of environment you like.

January

- ✓ Get your social security number.
- ✓ Register for ACT (February, April, June test dates)
- ✓ Sign up to do a computer college search in the College and Career Center using “Choices” or Tcci.naviance.
- ✓ Talk with your counselor or the College and Career Center coordinator about colleges.
- ✓ Use the Tcci.naviance website to help formulate an appropriate list of colleges.

February

- ✓ Select meaningful challenging courses for senior year.
- ✓ Write or email colleges for view books, catalogs and applications; ask to be on the school’s mailing list.
- ✓ Register for the spring SAT (March, May, June test dates).

March

- ✓ Register for SAT and/or SAT Subject Tests (May, June test dates).
- ✓ Registrar for ACT (April, June test dates).
- ✓ Begin to evaluate the college information you receive.
- ✓ Make plans for spring break college visits by checking the times of campus tours and information sessions. Get this information in the College and Career Center or access it on the college website.
- ✓ Arrange for a campus interview, if available.
- ✓ Register for Advanced Placement Tests.

April

- ✓ Evaluate material from your spring break college visits.
- ✓ Eliminate some schools from your original list.
- ✓ Attend Montgomery County College Fair at Montgomery Fairgrounds.
- ✓ Attend College Admissions Night program at BCC.
- ✓ Complete Self-Assessment and prepare resume of your achievements and awards. Email these documents to your counselor.
- ✓ Schedule college meeting with counselor.
- ✓ If you have not done so already, register for SAT and/or Subject Tests (June)

May

- ✓ Register for ACT (June test date).
- ✓ Complete Self-Assessment and prepare resume of achievements and awards. Email these documents to your counselor, if you have not done so already.
- ✓ Schedule college meeting with counselor, if you have not done so already.
- ✓ Take Advanced Placement Tests and/or IB Tests
- ✓ Check email and lists posted around school for date and time of Graduation Agreement meeting with your counselor.
- ✓ Check College and Career Center for summer jobs, summer programs, and volunteer opportunities.
- ✓ Register for summer school, if necessary.

June/Summer

- ✓ Plan college visits during summer vacation.
- ✓ Outline personal statement required by many colleges.
- ✓ Organize college applications as they arrive and begin work on essay questions.
- ✓ Take some time to rest and relax.
