

Senior Year Calendar

August/September

- ✓ Register for October SAT/ACT and/or November SAT or SAT Subject Test.
- ✓ Update resume of activities and achievements and submit to counselor.
- ✓ Sign up for and attend visits of college representatives in the College and Career Center (throughout the fall).
- ✓ Turn in "Release of Information" form to school registrar.
- ✓ Request application from colleges or visit college website and complete application on-line.
- ✓ Make final college visits, attend classes, and set up interviews, if available.
- ✓ Explore scholarship opportunities in the College and Career Center.

October

- ✓ For **early decision**, submit "Request for Transcripts" form, the B-CC Secondary School Report form (your section completed) and 9"x12" envelopes (each with 3 stamps and address of college) to school registrar **4** weeks before due date.
- ✓ Continue visiting colleges and attending programs and meetings with college representatives.
- ✓ Attend test preparatory class (optional) or access Triumph tutorial program for SAT/ACT practice.
- ✓ Register for November/December SAT, SAT Subject Tests, or ACT, if necessary.
- ✓ Attend Financial Aid Night program at B-CC.

November

- ✓ Attend Prep for Test program at B-CC.
- ✓ For **regular decision**, submit "Request for Transcripts" form, the B-CC Secondary School Report form (your section completed) and 9"x12" envelopes (each with 3 stamps and address of college) to school registrar **4** weeks before due date.

December

- ✓ Submit all transcript request forms by December 1 for January 1 deadlines.
- ✓ Receive early decision notification and inform school registrar of school decisions.

January - February

- ✓ Continue submitting college applications with later due dates.
- ✓ For mid-year report, provide school registrar with business size envelopes for each college you have applied to (1 stamp, addressed).
- ✓ Submit a FAFSA for financial aid after January 1.
- ✓ Double check that each school has received all necessary materials.

April

- ✓ Check your mail. College decisions should be arriving for regular decision applications.
- ✓ Visit colleges that have accepted you. Stay overnight and attend a few classes.
- ✓ Finalize your decision.

May 1

- ✓ By this date, you must mail your decision to the colleges.
- ✓ Write all colleges that accepted you, but that you did not select, and withdraw your application.
- ✓ Notify counseling office of your decision and provide school registrar with business size envelope, stamped, and addressed to the college you have decided to attend. This is for your final transcript.

Post-Graduation

- ✓ Final grades are sent to colleges in July – admission is provisional pending these.
- ✓ Turn your attention to creating list of items to take to college!!
