

# Exhibition Guidelines for Your MYP Personal Project

- On or before **March 9, 2012**, complete the
  - **Exhibition Questionnaire,**
  - **Exhibition Display Placard, and your**
  - **Personal Statement Report for submission to Ms. Mirkow in the MYP Office (C-214).**
- Students who do not turn in a completed questionnaire on time **WILL NOT** be eligible to have their projects displayed at the Exhibition Fair on April 19, 2012.
- By **March 9, 2012**, you will:
  - submit the final version of your project to your mentor for evaluation;
  - follow the personal report guidelines in the *Student Guide to the Personal Project* (beginning on page 5) and submit two copies of the final draft of your Personal Statement Report:
    - ***one copy for evaluation to your mentor and***
    - ***one copy to Ms. Mirkow in the MYP Office (C-214).***

By **March 9, 2012**, you will:

- Create an exhibition display placard that includes:
  - the title of your project;
  - your area of interaction;
  - your name;
  - a brief statement of your project's goal – for example: “I wanted to see whether I could design and create a dress. I wanted to understand the skills and steps necessary to clothing design and production.”
- Exhibition display placard should be
  - typed on a sheet of 8 ½” x 11” paper;
  - attached to 8 ½” x 11” poster board or foam core.
- Exhibition display placard template can be located on the B-CC Website or on Edline.
- ***Submit exhibition display placard to Ms. Mirkow in MYP Office (C-214).***

# Important Points to Remember:

- If your project is something that cannot be displayed, such as a community service event:
  - create a poster or other visual that explains what you did for your project – perhaps with photographs of the event, the cause you were working for, and the amount of money raised;
  - be sure your poster or visual display is neatly put together and that it captures the important aspects of your project.
- Be clever and creative in selecting a title and be sure it represents the content of your project.
- Overall, is the presentation of your project pleasing to the eye? Is clear? Is it neat? Is it colorful? Is it creative?
- You will have table space for your project...you may use that space however you like.
