We would like you to be aware of what Brooke Grove Elementary School is doing to help your child use the Internet. Students will not be allowed to access the Internet unless they are responsible and safe in their electronic search for information. In addition, all students must have a clearly defined activity or lesson that was given to them by a teacher. MCPS policy states that "no elementary student will be accessing the Internet unless under adult supervision." Students will be instructed on Computer Etiquette. Please read the Acceptable Use Policy with your child carefully.

TEACHER-STUDENT INTERNET ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The student agrees to the following rules for using computers and the Internet at Brooke Grove Elementary School.

1. Using the computer at Brooke Grove Elementary School is a right that I have as long as I follow the school rules for using the computer and the Internet.
2. I will only use the Internet for the assignments that I have been given by my teacher.
3. I will only use the Internet at school if an adult is present.
4. I will use the computer, Internet, and related software respectfully.
5. I will never bring discs or CDs from home to use on the school computers.
6. I will never give my full name, address, or telephone number to another person on-line.
7. Unless I have school permission, I will never give my e-mail address at home to another person on-line.
8. If I see or read something on the Internet that upsets me or that I feel is wrong, I will turn off the computer screen and raise my hand to get my teacher's attention.

If parents agree with this no further action is necessary.
